About Us

The RedSnook Catch & Release Charity Fishing Tournament, hosted by the Conservancy of Southwest Florida supports efforts to protect our most valuable natural resource, our water. Without clean and abundant water, recreational and sport fishing would not exist.



Over the years, the funds raised at the RedSnook Catch & Release Charity Fishing Tournament have helped support the Conservancy's water quality work, including:

- Providing assistance and expertise to water quality projects at the local, state, and federal levels.
- Creating the "Estuaries Report Card," which rates the condition of our region's vital waters.
- Working to limit the amount of pollution from the north that enters Southwest Florida's water.
- Researching and monitoring juvenile gamefish habitats.
- Helping to restore the Western Everglades and Ten Thousand Islands.
- Working to protect the Ten Thousand Islands, Big Cypress, Estero Bay, the Cocohatchee Slough, and the Caloosahatchee River.
- In partnership with the Sanibel-Captiva Conservation Foundation and Captains for Clean Water, funding a thorough analysis of the economic repercussions of degraded water quality.
- Sponsoring the reception at the Annual Everglades Coalition Conference with representatives from 57 local, state, and national environmental organizations working to protect and restore the Greater Everglades Ecosystem.
